

2025 Hell Survivors Charity Paintball Tournament

This charity paintball tournament is organized to honor and support our first responders. The event aims to provide an enjoyable and competitive experience while promoting camaraderie and raising funds for a noble cause.

Field information:

We are a family owned and operated business. The owner has been in the public safety field for over 20 years. He has served as a firefighter, critical care paramedic, and has an associate's in criminal justice.

This is our way of providing a fun time for those that serve and help give to a charity. Last year we hosted Ann Arbor FD vs PD in an event where PD won. When visiting, you will be able to sit in a covered seated area and watch the battles taking place on the "Grinder and Castle." Snacks and drinks are available in our concession stand. Games will also be placed out for family and friends that are accompanying you to enjoy while you are out playing. For those that are 21+ our Tiki Bar will be open for you to enjoy responsibly.

Other Donations

Some of our home team members have offered to grill for the event. Determined to end veteran suicide, K9's for Warriors is the nations largest provider of trained service dogs to military veterans suffering from PTSD, traumatic brain injury and/or militarysexual trauma. They are also the highest rated veteran service dog organization in the nation.

All Proceeds from this will be donated to K9's for Warriors.

Teams:

- Teams shall consist of a total of seven players.
- Teams shall consist of no less than 4 members of a first responder field. (For example, a team representing law enforcement must have no less than 4 law enforcement personnel. These four law enforcement personnel can be from the same department or combination of agencies. Teams will be allowed to have three non-first responder members Which we will call "Rookies".) If you need assistance in filling your roster, you may reach out to the field as we have our members looking to participate.
- On the day of the event, your members must show credentials.
- Each team must have a captain who shall be the contact person for their respective team
- Teams can be sponsored by their agency or self-sponsored. Each team shall produce their own team's name.
- Teams are encouraged to wear team jerseys or matching shirts but not obligated too.
- Each Team that Registers must sign up with their Charity of choice that will be announced at the briefing and where 100% of the Registration proceeds will be going to in honor of them.
- All players must have our waiver filled out before playing. Please have all players do so before arriving at our field to not delay play time. When you register it will send an email

Game Play:

- Game shall be on Saturday 21 June 2025.
- Gates open 0900.
- Check-In starts at 0930.
- Game briefing starts at 1100
- Game on shall commence at 1200.
- Tournament will be played in bracket style matches with "Team A" vs "Team B."
- The winner shall advance to the next round. The losing team shall move to a second bracket. This will be played as a double elimination tournament. If a team loses one game, they can still advance to the finals. If a team loses two games, they are out.
- Play will continue until a winner is determined.
- Games will be played on various fields located on our property. Fields range from close quarters to open area. Each game will be played as "Team Elimination," meaning all players from the opposing team must be eliminated to win.

Winner:

- The winning team shall be presented with a trophy commemorating their accomplishment.
- 100% of the Registration fees will be combined in one winning check and given to the winning team for their Charity they were playing for.
- Following the tournament play, anyone that participated in the tournament may continue to play paintball until the end of our business hours.

Fees:

- Each team member that is playing shall pay a \$30 registration fee that will be donated to the winning teams' charity of choice.
- The registration fee covers game play and if needed renting of marker, mask, pod pack, three pods, and unlimited air refills.
- Paint must be purchased from the field.
- Registration is due by 14 June 2025.

Registration fee must be paid by June 14, 2025 by cash or check. No credit cards accepted for registration due to all the proceeds are going for a charity, however CCs will be accepted elsewhere during the event. Paint, drinks, snacks and more.

Field Rules:

• We operate this facility with the "3-strikes and you're out" program. This means if you are violating any of these rules or displaying any un-Sportsman like conduct, your wristband will be marked, and a safety violation will be reported to the field manager. The third violation will result in you being removed from play, and you will be ejected from the premises with no refunds. If the violation is sufficiently serious, you may be banned from Hell Survivors Paintball Playfield permanently! Briefing is Mandatory for all players the day of this event. We will be going over all of the game rules and safety for everyone. We recommend visiting Hellsurvivors.com for all of our Safety and Field Rules to be better prepared when arriving to our field.

No missiles, tanks, helicopters etc...Markers only. No First strikes allowed for this game. Paint grenades and Smoke grenades are allowed but must be Hell Survivors grenades only. Any outside paint or Smoke grenades can result in the removal of the game with no refunds. Please respect these rules for the safety of the players and refs. This is a Field paint only game. Any paint purchased for this paint must be Hell Survivors paint of either GI or Deathball. Any paint leftover from this game that is our normal full price cost will be accepted at an open play or other event games. Any discounted paint for this game will only be allowed at Monster Game BYOP games. Any outside paint found at this game will give us the right to disqualify you from the game with no refund. This is for the safety of our players and refs.

ON-LINE RELEASE FORM/WAIVER:

- NO ONE can play without a signed release form.
- If you are under 18 years of age, your parents must sign your release form.
 All players are responsible for their rental equipment and must have a valid drivers license or picture ID, for collateral until equipment is returned at the end

of play.
